**AUTO THEFT PREVENTION**

The **Seminole County SO** brought a static display with signs offering tips on how to prevent your vehicle from being stolen.

They also brought a display of items a car thief will use to enter a secured vehicle. This is easy to make with a piece of wood and angle iron.

They also offer the Combat Auto Theft (CAT) program to seniors.

They produce handouts entitled "Is Your Vehicle a Crime Waiting to Happen?" that list ways to prevent your vehicle from being stolen.

**Kissimmee Police Department** offers its residents a flier that can be folded to look like a card, with the Kissimmee PD badge on the front. When opened, it offers tips on Auto Theft Prevention. They put these on vehicles in parking lots and areas where vehicle thefts have been a problem.
