**NEW BUSINESS:** Guest speakers were at the meeting from Target security, Frances Cortes and Flora Tran. They provided a great presentation and it was very informative. Their contact information will be attached. Thanksgiving holiday project, Brevard County had two families, Orlando PD had one family, and Winter Garden PD had one family to assist. ## ROUNDTABLE:

**Marriott Vacation Club:** Just got back from a conference. He advised that the merchants will have to modernize their equipment. Don't forget that we have a website. **UCF PD** They just received \$20,000 to buy a vehicle for the SAFE escort program. He is also going to provide a SAFE program which is a 2hr self-defense course. They are going to offer it every day on campus. They have had 12 burglaries in one residential area. They are targeting girls who live alone and they enter the resident while the owners are home. They also had a bike auction. They take abandoned bikes and auction them off, the proceeds go to student scholarships.

**Lake County SO:** Having our annual Sheriff's Citizen Alumni Barbeque.

**Winter Garden PD:** They did a program with Channel 6, which showed how easily kids are lured. They are looking for any information to give parents for training. (Brevard will email info to them)

**Sonitrol:** The presentation from the conference will be posted on the PCPA website and also on our CFCPA web. Partners against crime in Tampa are doing well. There have been approximately 159,000 apprehensions with the video verification services.

**Orange County S.O.:** (Bryan Tittle, new region 5 Director) advised that the next FCPA conference is going to be in Destin, Florida next year. He is in charge of getting vendors to participate. If you have any contacts, please let him know. Also, if there are any news articles that you would like to submit, FCPA is doing a newsletter. Please submit to Bryan as soon as you can. He also wants any input, concerns that we may have. The next conference, the South East region Crime Prevention Practitioners are going to be invited.
