**Apopka PD** – Preparing for Foliage Fest and recently completed a crime prevention presentation directed at high school seniors heading off to college. They are also preparing for their 3<sup>rd</sup> Youth Academy.

**Oviedo PD** – They have teamed up with Palm Tree Computers to create a child ID system and internet tracking software.
