Home Security

- S** Secure your home with good locks on doors and windows.
- T** Take care of your keys. *DON'T* give others a chance to duplicate them.
- O** Outside of your home should look occupied and be well kept.
- P** Put the lights on at night and while you are away.
- T** Take time to look before opening a door. Don't open your door to strangers.
- H** Have the police or a trusted neighbor check your home if you are away for a few days.
- I** Insure your possessions, keep an updated inventory.
- E** Engrave Driver License Number on items preferred by thieves. Keep valuables in a safe deposit box.
- F** Find out about burglar alarm systems and have one installed.

Auto Theft

- S** Stolen and burglarized vehicles are now the most prevalent of property crimes.
- T** Take garage door opener out of plain view ... don't give a thief a key to your home.
- O** Out of sight and out of mind ... place packages and valuables out of plain view.
- P** Park in well-lit areas.
- T** Tag or license plate should have current owner name and address on it.
- H** Hide business cards or other identification with numbers on it in your vehicle door panel, under seats, etc. for identification if stolen.
- E** Exercising greater care with property will prevent crime.
- F** Find your keys before you get to your car.
- T** Theft causes lost work time and inconvenience.

Help **STOP** Crime

Personal Attack

- S** Shop during the day if possible.
- T** Take a friend if you need to be out at night.
- O** Opportunity that is not there will prevent the attack from happening.
- P** Pay attention to your surroundings.
- A** Alertness is the key ... Keep looking around you.
- T** Take note of where your car is parked so you don't have to look for it.
- T** Targets are chosen by easy opportunity ... Don't be one.
- A** Always CALL POLICE immediately, tell everything you can about your attacker.
- C** Can you fight back? ... Know your limitations.
- K** Keep a clear mind and use common sense in any situation. It may save your life.
